CALL TO CONVENTION

MASSACHUSETTS BUILDING TRADES COUNCIL

103rd ANNUAL CONVENTION MGM SPRINGFIELD

January 5, 2022

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

The Massachusetts Building Trades Council will hold its 103rd Annual Convention at the MGM Springfield, March 14-16, 2022.

Registration for the Convention will begin at 10:00 AM on Monday, March 14th. The convention opens at 12:00 noon Monday, March 14th and adjourns on Wednesday, March 16th after the morning session.

In compliance with Article V, Section 5 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Massachusetts Building Trades Council, AFL-CIO, a Credential Form is enclosed.

DELEGATE FEE IS \$350 PER DELEGATE.

DELEGATE REPRESENTATION is determined by Article III Sections 1 and 2 of the Constitution and By-Laws:

ARTICLE III

Representation

Section 1. The basis of representation of all Locals to the convention shall be three (3) delegates for the first 250 members or fraction thereof; and one (1) delegate for each additional 150 members on the Local's rolls as of the last day of the previous year. A Local Union and/or Building Trades Council in arrears as of the first day of the convention shall not be seated. Any delegate or delegates finding themselves not in good standing, will have an opportunity to review such standing with the Credentials Committee, and the Executive

Officers of the Council on the first day of the Convention between 4:00 and 5:00 p.m. The Committee shall review the circumstances and accept or reject any and all last payments of per capita and assessments. The Committee's decision shall be final. Each delegate shall be entitled to one (1) vote. Each Building Trades Council in Massachusetts shall be entitled to three (3) delegates. Each Craft Council in Massachusetts shall be entitled to one (1) delegate.

Section 2. In localities where there are more than one Local Union of the same International Union, each Local Union shall be entitled to delegates according to their membership as provided in Article III, Section 1.


